

**4) Teachers as they stand in front of our children day after day.**

Ephesians 5:1 “Therefore be imitators of God as dear children.” *(Jesus, we ask You to help our teachers be the model of Christ to our children. May they be imitators of Christ in love, mercy, grace, and in compassion for the students.)*

**5) Wisdom for Christian teachers as they share their life experiences**

James 1:5 “If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him.” *(God, you are all knowing, all powerful, and always present. Your Word says for us to ask You for wisdom and You will give it freely to anyone who asks. Lord we ask for Your wisdom for our teachers.)*

**6) Teachers, students, and staff who are not Christians that they may come to know Christ.**

Mt. 5:16 “In the same way let your light shine before men that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.” *(Father, may our actions and the actions of our teachers lead our children and others to faith in Jesus Christ for salvation.)*

**7) The safety and welfare of the students in school and travelling to and from school.**

Ephesians 5:21 “Submitting to one another in the fear of God.” *(Lord, help each family member submit to You first, then to each other.)*

**8) The parents and families of the students as they encourage and support their children and the schools.**

Ephesians 6:4b “...Bring them up in the training and admonition of the Lord.” *(Dear Jesus, help the families to bring the children up in a good and godly fashion.)*

**9) The improvement of the home environment of many students.**

1 Corinthians 13:13 “And now abide faith, hope, love, these three; but the greatest of these is love.” *(God, help faith, hope and love to be dominant in each home.)*

**10) The parents who do not encourage and support their children's education.**

Luke 2:52 “And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and men.” *(Jesus, help parents and children alike to grow up like you did.)*

**11) The positive interaction of students with each other.**

1 Corinthians 13:4-6. “Love suffers long and is kind.” *(Lord, help students to learn early that loving people is the way we should live).*

**12) The children who are involved in bullying or other negative behavior.**

1 Corinthians 13:5 “Love... does not behave rudely, is not provoked, thinks no evil.” *(Lord, help bullying and negative behavior to be replaced with your love).*

**13) Safety for students and teachers as they travel to and from school.**

Psalms 3:3. “But You, O Lord, are a shield for me, my glory and the One who lifts up my head.” *(Jesus, be a shield of protection to all who travel to and from school).*

**14) Safety and protection for the students while using the restrooms as this is one of the most difficult places to monitor.**

Ps. 46:1 “God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in time of trouble.” *(Lord, be ever present in these places, that order, safety and righteousness will prevail.)*

**15) Continued good financial support of Colquitt County teachers.**

Luke 10:7, “For the laborer is worthy of his wages.” *(God, please provide for our teachers and help them be good stewards of all they receive.)*

**16) Students to apply themselves to get a good education.**

2 Timothy 2:15 “Be diligent to present yourself approved to God...” *(Lord, help students to give 100% of their effort to be approved before you.)*

**17) Health for our students and teachers as flu season approaches and throughout the year.**

3 John 1:2a “Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in all things and be in health,” *(We pray that you may enjoy good health and that all may go well with you this year.)*

**18) Christian students and teachers to be encouraged by the power of the Holy Spirit.**

Romans 15:13 “Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.” *(We pray that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.)*

**19) Positive reinforcement of learning from sports activities in the schools.**

Proverbs 1:5 “A wise man will hear and increase learning, and a man of understanding will attain wise counsel.” *(We pray that the wise listen and add to their learning.)*

**20) Coaches, assistant coaches and volunteers in all sports activities.**

Colossians 3:23 “And whatever you do, do it heartily, as to the Lord and not to men,” *(We pray that whatever you do, work at it with all your heart.)*

**21) Positive encouragement from all club activities.**

Ecclesiastes 4:9 "Two are better than one, because they have a good reward for their labor." *(We pray that in all club activities students learn that two are better than one, because they have a good return for their labor.)*

**22) Bus drivers to have clear minds, quick reflexes and God's protection while driving.**

Proverbs 3:5-6 "Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding; In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths." *(Dear Lord, through the many days of school this year please give our school bus drivers a calm and guided safety in the delivering of our children to and from school. Please help our children to be obedient and cooperate in their ride to school. Thank you Lord.)*

**23) Parents, grandparents, foster parents and other guardians to provide the best possible environment for the students.**

Proverbs 22:6 "Train up a child in the way he should go, and when he is old he will not depart from it." *(Dear Lord, we know it is our privilege to have the oversight of these children both at Home and at School. Help us to be blessed in our effort to provide guidance, instruction, and examples. Thank You Lord.)*

**24) Health and medical needs of students and staff.**

**26) Clear focus, time restraints and job opportunities for ABAC and Moultrie Tech. students.**

2 Timothy 2:15 "Be diligent to present yourself approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth." *(Dear Lord, please help our college and career students to come to the knowledge of the value of study and grant to them fruit for their studies and reward them for the effort they put forth.)*


